Report for St Mary Bourne Annual Parish Assembly 2024

St Mary Bourne United Charities was renamed **St Mary Bourne Parish Community Fund** in June 2023. A new logo was designed to show the villages and hamlets within St Mary Bourne parish. Information and posters were displayed on noticeboards throughout the parish, in the doctors' surgeries, and in Hill & Valley.

The St Mary Bourne Parish Community fund (PCF) can help anyone living in the parish of St Mary Bourne who finds themselves in financial difficulty due to illness or unexpected circumstances. It also supports local organisations such as the Kingfisher Centre (day care for the elderly), the Andover Food Bank, and the local school if there is a specific need. The fund is extremely grateful for the generous donation given to it from the proceeds of the 2023 Flower Show and Fete. This enabled it to respond more generously whenever a parishioner needed help.

There are six trustees: Marion Brighty, Bridget Culley, Helen Little, Rev Canon Dodie Marsden, Ruth Widen (Clerk/Trustee) and Alison Wogan. Two of the trustees represent the Church and the Medical Practice and the others are nominated by the Parish Council to cover all ages and areas of the parish. Helen Little has been the Fund's Parish Council representative in the village school for the past ten years. She is retiring at the end of the summer term. The trustees are very grateful for all the help and advice she has given and wish her well on her retirement.
